eHealth deployment in Finland

Fill in the missing words or numbers

Public sector covers about *75* % of the Finnish health care services. Patients pay a small *fee* for health care visits. Currently there are *21* hospital districts in Finland. In 2023 hospital districts will be transferred to 21 *wellbeing service counties*. Private sector and *occupational* health care provide supplementary services (*25* % of expenditure). Centralized statistics are collected via various *registers*.

Electronic Patient Records were implemented in all health care services in Finland by *2010*. When comparing hospitals and health centers, *hospitals* have typically been forerunners in the progress of availability of the electrical services. Citizens were ready for e-services already in late *2000*'s. Availability of remote consultations increased already *before* start of COVID-19 pandemic. The use of Finnish *Health Information Exchange* Kanta services increased *after* start of COVID-19 pandemic. In international EU-comparisons e.g. Nordic countries have been *forerunners* in eHealth use. In Finland almost *50* % of people have used eHealth services.

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
